

B. THERE IS / ARE and the articles A / AN / ANY / SOME

There is + singulier
There are + pluriel

= il y a

On utilise **SOME** dans les phrases affirmatives et **ANY** dans les phrases négatives et les questions.

ex: *There are some pens in the bag.*

Are there any messages for me? No, there aren't any.

➤ Complète les phrases. Utilise **There is a/an** ou **There are**:

- 1) There is a black table in the dining room.
- 2) **There are** two doors in our living room.
- 3) **There are** four white chairs in our kitchen.
- 4) **There are** three posters on the wall in my bedroom.
- 5) **There is an** armchair in my sister's room.

(-) No, **There aren't**

- 6-the pot is **on/in** the cooker.
- 7-the bin is **near/ in front of** the drawers.
- 8-the microwave **is next to /under the** window
- 9-the sink is **behind /under** the window.



There is a plant **behind** the big sofa.

There is a DVD player and some DVDs **under** the TV

There is a cassette player **on** the TV
