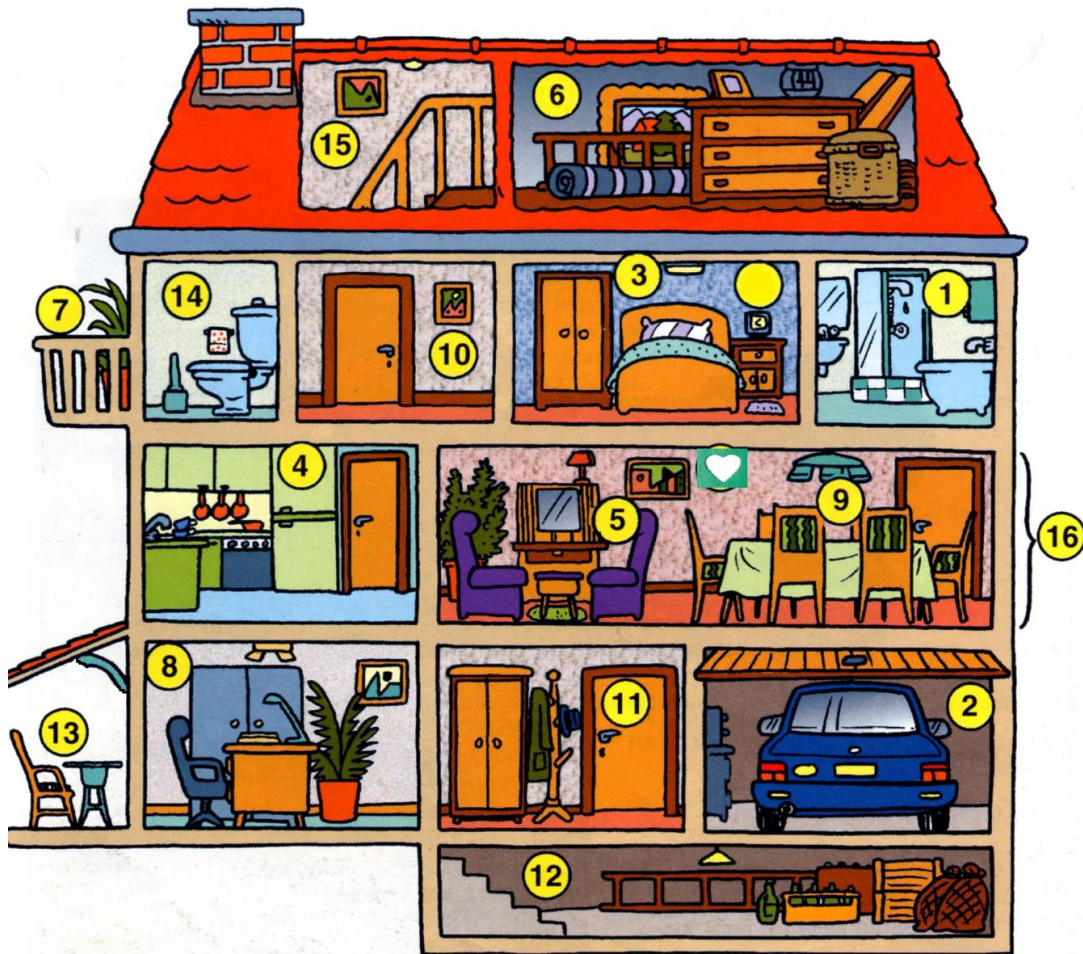

*Are there **any** messages for me? No, there aren't **any**.*
